



LAKE BORUMBA AUSTRALIAN BASS, GOLDEN PERCH AND SOUTHERN SARATOGA 2011-2020 2020 REVIEW

Stocked fish numbers, tagged and recaptured fish, catch rates, fish sizes, growth, locations and recapture fisher postcodes


The following dashboard provides a summary of Australian Bass, Golden Perch and Southern Saratoga for Lake Borumba covering the past 10 years.

Summary

- Dam level at the 31 Dec was 78.3%
- From 2011-2018 there were 227K Bass and 225K Golden Perch fingerlings released
- Over the past 10 years there have been 2,671 Bass tagged for 170 recaptures (6.4%), 113 Golden Perch for 2 recaptures (1.8%) and 160 Southern Saratoga for 7 recaptures (4.4%)
- The Bass catch rate in 2020 was 7.7 fish/fisher day which was above the 10 year average of 5.1 fish/fisher day while for Golden Perch it was 0.2 fish/fisher day and for Saratoga it was 0.1 fish/fisher day
- The average length of Bass in 2020 was 315mm and range from 200-470mm
- The percentage of legal Bass in 2020 was 62.6% with 0% trophy fish 500mm and over
- The longest time out for a tagged Bass is 11.5 years but that is expected to be longer as tagging has only been significant since 2008
- Annual Bass growth calculated from tag recaptures at the end of year 1 is 32mm and at the end of year 5 is 89mm
- Over the past 10 years most Bass and Golden Perch have been tagged in LBY map grids E34, D34 and F34 while most Saratoga have been tagged in D34 and E33
- Of the Bass recaptured over the past 10 years 22 have been recaptured below the dam with 11 caught in Yabba Creek and 10 in Mary River
- Over the past 10 years most postcodes of fishers recapturing fish are 4570 (Gympie), 4014 (Virginia area), 4505 (Burpengary) and 4305 (Ipswich area)
- There have been 6 fish recaptured by fishers with postcodes outside Queensland with 4 from NSW, 1 from VIC and 1 from WA

Data sources

Data used in the Impoundment Crystal Bowl are:

- Tag records and recapture records for the impoundment at http://crystalbowl.infofishaustralia.com.au/
- Dam level data from SEQwater at https://www.seqwater.com.au/historic-dam-levels
- Stocked fish records from https://www.data.qld.gov.au/dataset/queensland-freshwater-fish-stocking-records/
- Bathymetric data from Infofish surveys or other sources

Basis for analysis

- Catch rates calculated as number of fish tagged/fisher/day for T20 fishers (taggers) with a minimum of 12 fisher days (at least 1 per month) to provide a reliable catch rate
- Undersized Bass and Golden Perch are <300mm, legal fish are >=300 and <500mm and trophy fish are >=500mm
- Undersized Southern Saratoga are <500mm, legal fish are >=500 and <700mm and trophy fish are >=700mm
- Growth calculated using logarithmic curve from recaptures where fish were out for 90 days or more and had positive growth
- Locations based on Infofish grid map LBY for the impoundment and other grid maps where fish were recaptured outside the impoundment
- Distance moved was the shortest distance by water between the tag and recapture location measured in Google Earth
