Summary

- From 2011-2020 there were 7,755 fish tagged in the Weipa area for 79 recaptures (1.0%)
- Key species tagged were Barramundi 5,910 (76.2%) for 64 (1.1%) recaptures and Golden Snapper 840 (10.8%) for 7 (0.8%) recaptures accounting for 87.0% of all fish tagged
- There were 134 fisher days in 2020 which was the highest in the last 10 years and did not appear to be affected by Covid-19
- The tag rate for 2020 was 8.3 fish/fisher day and close to the 10 year average historic catch rate of 8.4 fish/fisher day
- For Barramundi the tag rate was a high 11.6 fish/fisher day in 2011 and a low of 3.1 in 2017 and was 5.6 in 2020
- For Golden Snapper the tag rate ranged was 0.2 fish/fisher day in 2018 down from 2.0 in 2017 however this was likely influenced by a change in those tagging
- Barramundi tagged in the Weipa area were mostly below the legal limit with just 11.4% being over the legal limit over the 10 years
- Barramundi growth was very variable but averaged just 81mm by the end of a year and 187mm by the end of year 5
- Of 64 Barramundi recaptured 30 (46.9%) were recaptured in the same area as tagged with the furthest movement being 20km upriver and 55km downriver
- All 7 Golden Snapper recaptured were caught in the same area as tagged with the longest time at liberty being 323 days (0.9 years)
- Weipa is mostly a localised fishery with 69% of recapture fishers being local while the remaining fishers came from widespread areas from Cairns to NSW



Basis for analysis

- Tag rates calculated as number of fish tagged/fisher day for taggers with a minimum of 12 fisher days (at least 1 per month) to provide an acceptable tag rate
- For Barramundi undersized fish are <580mm, legal fish are >=580 and <1000mm and trophy fish are >1000mm
- For Golden Snapper undersized fish are <350mm, legal fish are >=350 and <600mm and trophy fish are >=600mm
- Growth calculated using a logarithmic or linear trendline from recaptures where fish were out for 90 days or more and had positive growth
- Locations based on Infofish grid map WAB and other grid maps where fish were recaptured outside the area
- Movement distance calculated as the shortest distance by water from the tag to the recapture location
