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LAKE MANCHESTER OVERVIEW


Lake Manchester was first stocked in 2015 and since then there have been 39K Bass and 2.5K Mary River Cod released.


Fishing in Lake Manchester is limited to manually powered vessels and access to the lake is difficult which limits the extent of fishing in the lake. It is expected that most of the fishers that use the lake are locals from the Brisbane and Ipswich areas.


Tagging of Bass in the lake commenced in 2017 and since then there have been 241 fish tagged with 2 recaptures in the lake and 2 below the lake in the Brisbane River following the 2022 spill. There have been no recaptured reported below the lake since the spill in Mar this year.


Most Bass tagged in the lake have been over legal length in each year. This may suggest that the spillage of fish from the lake is fairly low.

There have been no recordings of Mary River Cod from the lake although they were able to be tagged from 2023. It is likely that the fishing techniques used for catching Bass are less likely to catch the Cod. There have been reports that they have been caught in the lake but those catching them have been secretive.






