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LAKE ADVANCETOWN OVERVIEW

Summary for 2025

- Tagging in Lake Advancetown continues to provide a 5-star rating providing reliable data on the fishery in the lake.
- The lake spilled again in 2025 with a further 6 fish recaptured below the dam in the Nerang River.

Lake Advancetown has been stocked with Australian Bass, Golden Perch, Silver Perch, Southern Saratoga and Mary River Cod. From 2014-2023 there were 577,7880 Bass, 75,207 Golden Perch, 1,500 Mary River Cod and 33,636 Silver Perch fingerlings stocked. These fish were a size that could be tagged from 2016-2025.

For every 10,000 fingerlings stocked there have been 164 Bass and 4 Golden Perch tagged. Eeltail Catfish are not stocked and are a self-sustaining native species. They have been tagged since 2020 as little is known about them in stocked lakes.


The lake is primarily an experiential fishery mostly fished by locals making up 93% of those recapturing tagged fish. Of those locals 67% live within the City of Gold Coast Local Government Area. Apart from locals, fishers recapturing fish are mostly from Ipswich, Brisbane, and northern NSW, with one fisher from Townsville and another from Victoria.

Fishing in the lake is limited to electric motors only resulting in lower effort and lower recapture rates than other similar lakes. Tag rates are high with a 10-year average of 14.0 fish/day however this is strongly influenced by some taggers using bait since 2020.


Tagging effort was reduced from Oct 2023-Jun 2024 due to a shortage of tags so tag rates over that time were lower than the actual catch rates. Tagging effort was again limited from Oct-Dec 2025 due to tag shortages. At over 9,000 fish tagged in the lake in the last 10 years this provides an adequate base for assessing the fishery.

Bass spilled from the lake during 2022 and 20 were recaptured below the dam in the Nerang River and 1 well upstream in the Coomera River from Apr 2022-2024. The lake spilled again at the end of 2024 and from Jan-May 2025. Follow that spill there have been a further 6 recaptured down from the dam with the furthest movement being 30km for a fish recaptured in Clear Water Lake.

LAKE ADVANCETOWN LOCATION







Gender of recapture






Lake level (% full)





Data sources

Data used in the Lake Advancetown Crystal Bowl are:

- Tag records and recapture records for the lake at <http://crystalbowl.infofishaustralia.com.au/>.
- Dam level data from SEQwater at <https://www.seqwater.com.au/historic-dam-levels>.
- Rainfall and temperature records from Station 040584 Hinze Dam and Station 040847 Hinze Dam HW Alert from <https://www.bom.gov.au/>.
- Stocked fish records from <https://www.data.qld.gov.au/dataset/queensland-freshwater-fish-stocking-records/>.

Basis for analysis

- Data reliability based on the sample size over the past 5 years for days fished by taggers, by fishers recapturing fish and fish tagged and recaptured.
- Catch rates calculated as number of fish tagged/fisher/day for T20 fishers (taggers) with a minimum of 12 fisher days (at least 1 per month) to provide a reliable catch rate.
- Undersized Bass are <300mm, legal fish are ≥ 300 and <500mm and trophy fish are ≥ 500 mm.
- Growth calculated using logarithmic curve from recaptures where fish were out for 90 days or more and had positive growth.
- Locations based on Infofish grid map ADV for the impoundment and other grid maps where fish were recaptured outside the impoundment.
- Survival rates are calculated based on a model that uses the reduction in the numbers of recaptures each year after tagging.
- Travel proxy distance is the distance between where the fisher lives (address, suburb, town or postcode) and the recapture location. Local <80km, intrastate Qld elsewhere, interstate other than Qld.
